## Additional information to 4CA013

The wetland type for permanent freshwater marshes is  $\mathbf{Tp}$ , not Sp, and the one for seasonal freshwater marshes is  $\mathbf{Ts}$ , not Ss. Additionally, type **F**, estuarine waters, is applicable since the site contains rivers ending at a sea bay (according to the map and the "physical features" section).

Criteria: 1a, 2b, 2c, 3a, 3b, 3c

Justification of criteria:

2b/2c: The site regularly hosts half a million shorebirds, and a large number of other waterbirds and raptors during summers.

3b: The site regularly supports large numbers of geese and waders during the breeding season 3c: The site hosts over 1% of the breeding population of the goose *Anser albifrons*, and it regularly hosts over 1% of the *Somateria mollissima* population

It must be added that these are 1970s data! There are no more recent data available. These data have been re-submitted in 1998.
