Additional information to 4CA024

The wetland type for permanent freshwater ponds is **Tp**, not Sp, and the type for impoundments is **6**, not 2.

The altitude of Oak Hammock is 267 m above sea level (taken from the first RIS for this site).

Criteria: 1a, 2c, 3a, 3b, 3c

Justification of some of the criteria:

2c/3b: The site is a very important breeding and staging area for waterfowl, especially geese and ducks. 3c: During fall migration, the site regularly supports far over 1% of the populations of the geese *Anser canadensis* and *Anser caerulescens atlanticus* (derived from Waterfowl Population Estimates II).
